Sound decisions enabled, missteps avoided, projects course-corrected, and leadership teams reassured through our strategic guidance



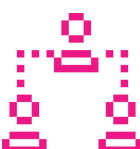

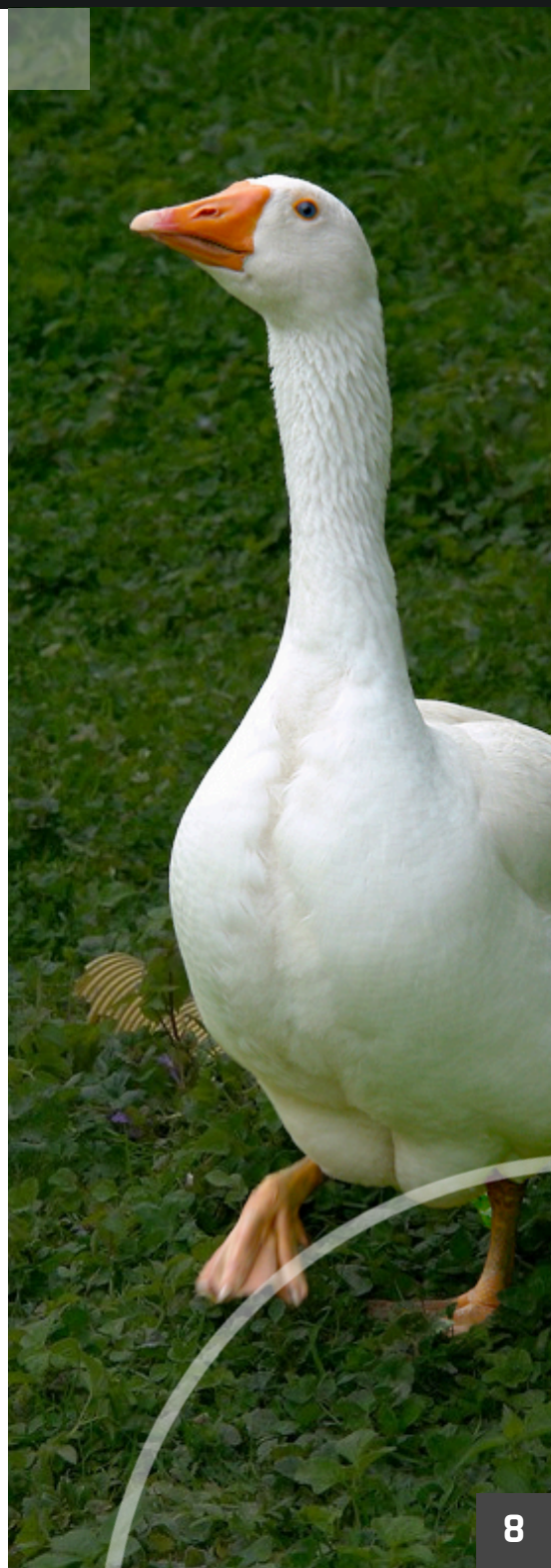

What We Do



Our work focuses on three core areas:



Tech Services

We leverage **technology** to help organizations **expand their reach** and **strengthen the impact** of their animal advocacy efforts worldwide. By streamlining processes and increasing efficiency, we help groups **save valuable time** so they can stay focused on their missions. Technology enables us to accelerate the movement's growth, ensuring its efforts are effective, accessible, and sustainable.



Flagship Programs

We build digital infrastructure to strengthen the movement, creating tools that solve shared challenges at scale. From connecting advocates through **Flockwork** (formerly Playground), to streamlining grantmaking with **Granti**, to enabling strategic collaboration via the **FAST Network** — our platforms go beyond individual solutions to support the entire ecosystem. By developing large-scale, cutting-edge tools, we amplify impact, drive collective efficiency, reduce costs, and boost the movement's capacity for change.



Community Support

We manage vegan communities with over **2 million** members, fostering positive spaces for connection, support, and activism. This includes co-managed Reddit communities like **r/vegan**, **r/veganactivism**, **r/animalrights**, and **r/veganrecipes**, as well as the **Animal Rights Advocates (ARA)** Discord server. Our support also extends to strengthening the movement through capacity-building meetups, conference talks, and free tools that boost efficiency and impact—such as our **Tech & Data in the Movement** study and **Productivity for Animal Advocates** ebook.

OUR TECH SERVICES



Website Building & Guidance

We help organizations seeking streamlined website solutions – either by building the site ourselves or guiding them through the process. Our sister organization, Violet Studios, offers advanced custom design websites, while we support orgs whose needs or timelines fall outside their capacity. For other cases, we refer orgs to Flockwork (Playground).



Tech & Organizational Advisory

We offer expert consulting across technology, user experience, and organizational strategy. From choosing the right tools and fixing bugs to advancing tech projects and improving operations, we provide reliable support tailored to the organization's work.



Digital Security Consultations

We help safeguard the movement by strengthening digital security. We advise organizations on best practices, tools, and protocols, and provide guidance during cyberattacks or other digital threats to ensure teams can stay protected and resilient.



AI Workshops & Consulting

We help organizations identify and implement the right AI tools for the right tasks – saving time and boosting productivity. We offer one-on-one consulting and lead workshops on how to use AI effectively, ethically, and strategically within advocacy work.

Grant Portal

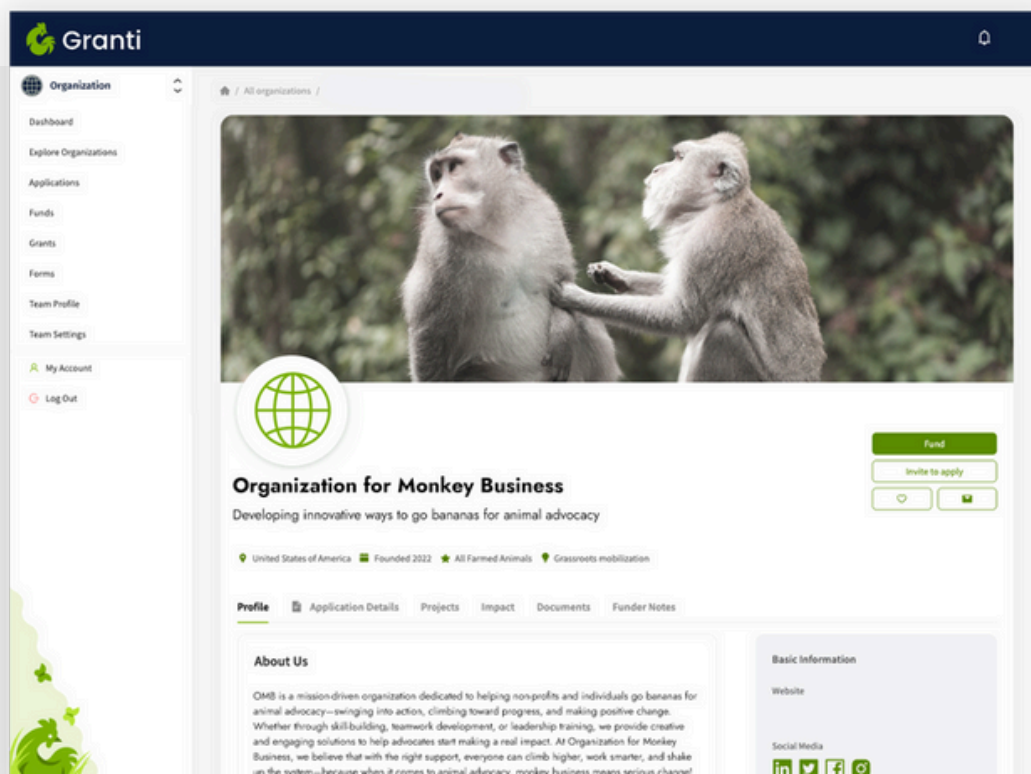
In 2023, we released a grantee-funder tool to **streamline grant management** and **improve the funding process** for animal advocates.

For grantees, keeping track of past and current grants can be overwhelming.

Managing follow-ups, submitting impact updates, updating banking or fiscal sponsorship details, forwarding receipts and documents, and maintaining communication with funders all require significant effort. Keeping funders informed about funding gaps, new matches, and relevant initiatives adds another layer of complexity.

Funders also face administrative burdens, often juggling multiple platforms to manage grantee submissions. Accessing key information in a clear, centralized format is rare, making the process inefficient.

Our tool bridges this gap — bringing funders and grantees together in a seamless system that simplifies and optimizes the grant process for everyone in the movement.

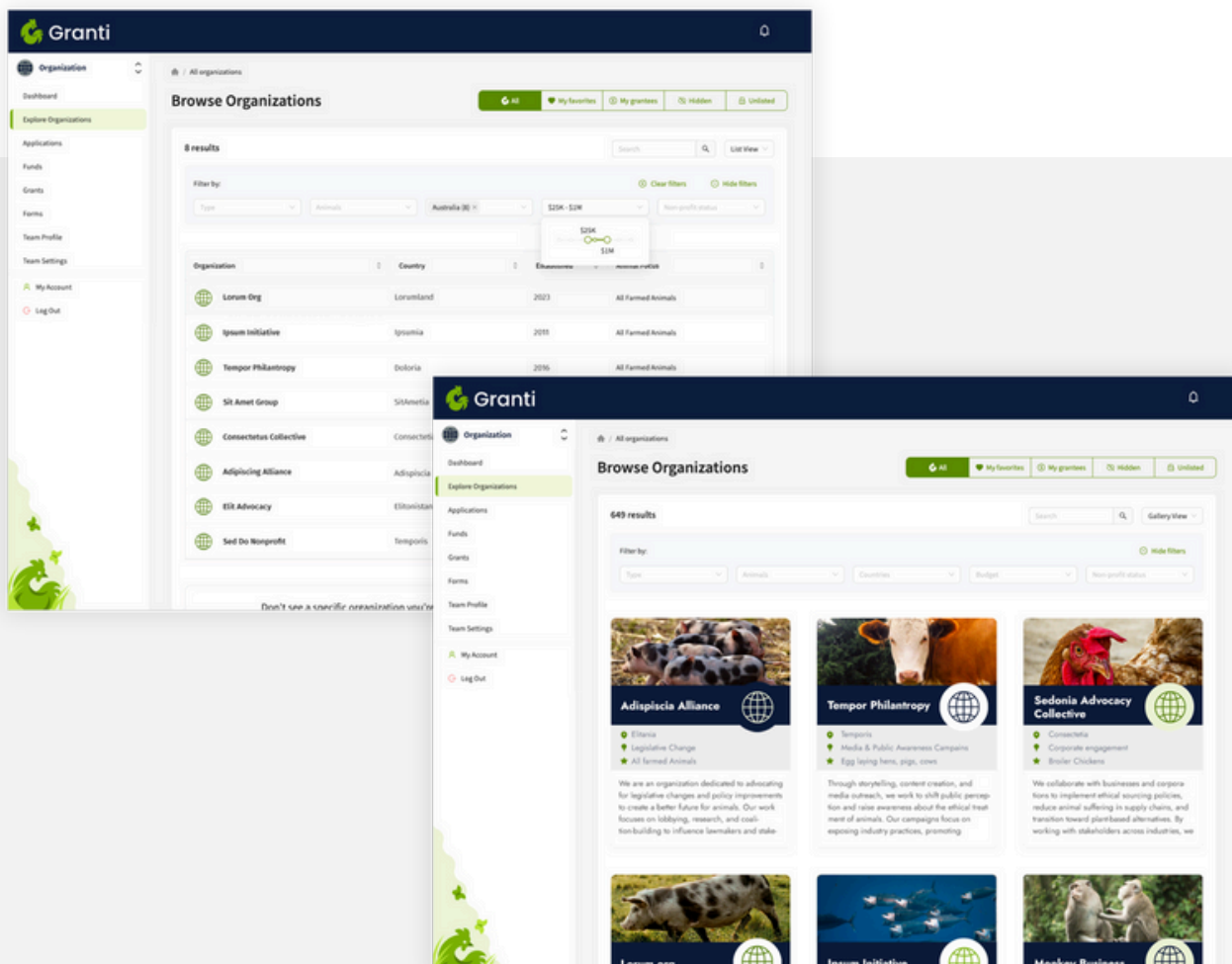

Granti V2

In 2024, after seeing major success with Granti, we explored ways to improve the platform even further. We began working on Granti V2 – an update (released in early 2025) featuring a revamped profile system that saves grantees time and provides funders with easier access to key information, making the entire process faster and more seamless than before.





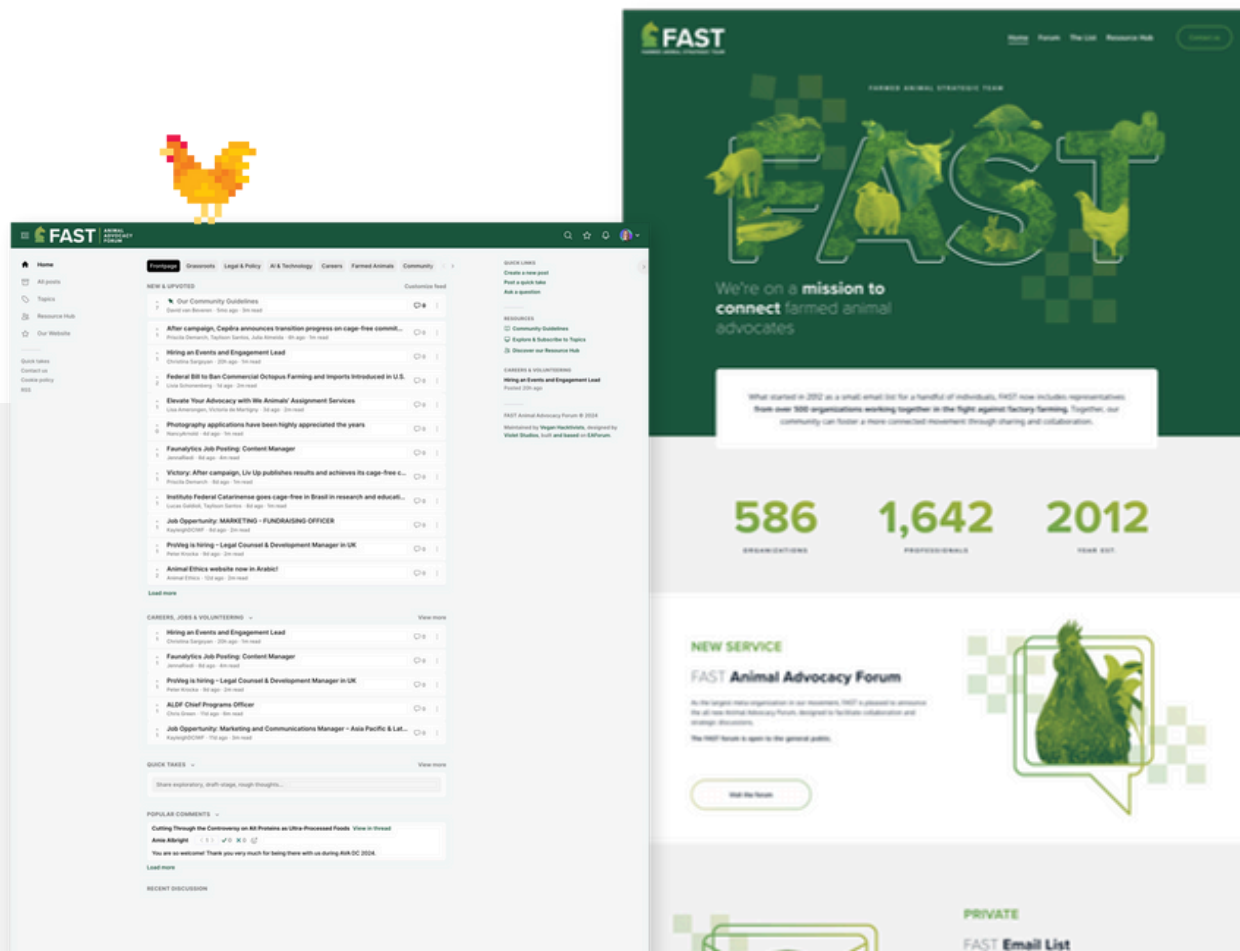

FAST Network

What began in 2012 as a small email list for a handful of individuals has grown into FAST, a **network representing over 600 organizations** united in the fight against factory farming.

Over the past decade, FAST was managed by various individuals within the movement until Vegan Hacktivists took on management in 2024. Since then, **our focus has been on expanding and enhancing FAST's value for its members.** This has included updating rules and processes, along with a comprehensive rebrand to reflect the community's evolution. Multiple surveys conducted since have shown strong member enthusiasm for these developments and the continued value FAST brings to the community.





FLAGSHIP PROJECT



What we did for FAST



New Website: We launched a brand-new website to better showcase the services and value our network offers to both current and prospective members.



Member Portal: We secured all private member data and built a dedicated portal where members can access contact details (like emails and phone numbers), connect directly, and engage with one another.



Discussion Forum: We launched a public forum to offer an additional space for members to collaborate and communicate. Plans are already in place to grow engagement and participation.



Our Academy: We developed a centralized hub where all movement-wide trainings and courses can be easily accessed — a feature that members have been particularly excited about!

The FAST community exchanges over 1,100 emails per year, making it **one of the best places to stay informed** about the movement and share your own updates!

Volunteer Matchmaking Platform

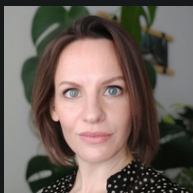
On Playground, volunteers bring a wide range of professional skills, from **technology** and **communications** to **design**, **research**, and **more**, collaborating with organizations from all over the world.

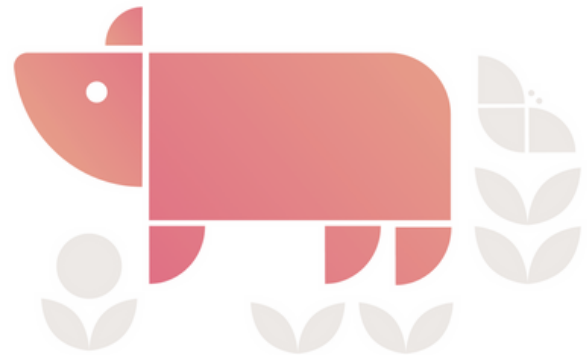

Coming in 2025: Playground Becomes Flockwork

Where professional animal advocates get **matched with skilled volunteers**

We are excited to announce the rebranding and expansion of our volunteer matchmaking platform, Flockwork, previously known as Playground. This enhanced platform will accommodate a broader range of professional skill sets, with volunteers engaging in both unpaid and stipend-based projects that match their unique skills and passions. By screening the applications ourselves, we ensure that the right people are placed on the right projects, all expertly matched to each organization's needs.



Set to launch in the Summer of 2025, Flockwork builds capacity and conserves resources for animal advocacy groups, enabling everyone involved to focus on what they do best. Volunteers around the world contribute their professional skills in the most meaningful and impactful ways, while organizations save time and money that they can put directly towards achieving our shared mission — helping animals facing systematic exploitation and wide scale suffering in the food system or in the wild.



ONLINE VEGAN COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT

We co-manage a wide range of vegan communities on Reddit, with a combined reach of over 2 million members. We use this platform to support organizations in our movement by helping them find the right volunteers, as well as hosting AMAs (Ask Me Anything), and increasing their visibility. Through active moderation and community-building, we also foster discussion and collaboration across the broader vegan community.

Productivity Ebook

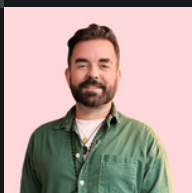

Our Goals for 2025-2026



Each year, we aim to meet these impact benchmarks:

In 2024, 71 requests were completed on Playground. While most are smaller in scope than full website builds, some require significant effort. Building on Playground's success — and with the launch of Flockwork in mid-2025 alongside increased marketing efforts — we aim to further grow the number of requests fulfilled through Flockwork.



Forward Fundraising & Diversification

We'd like to aim to fundraise and secure funding for at least 1-2 years ahead for our budget, as well as diversifying our funding sources to minimize the risk of key funders losing the capacity to support us due to unforeseeable events such as economic downturn or a shift in mission priorities.
